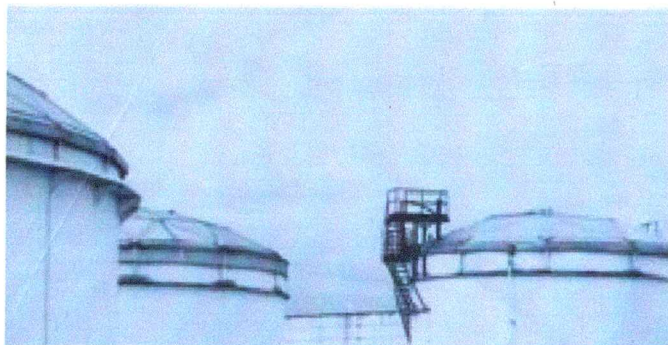

The Seattle artists made a name for themselves with their ferocious live performances in the electro-industrial act, Noxious Emotion. After playing years with NE, they opted to move on to their own musical creation: backandtotheleft. Taking a cue from other notable ebm/futurepop groups such as VNV Nation and Assemblage 23 backandtotheleft's music involves a melodic, dance floor-friendly approach to electronic music. Sometimes dark, sometimes upbeat, but always entertaining.

Now, after 2 years in the making, they are set to take the world's dancefloors by storm with "Obsolete," their frighteningly solid debut on Assemblage 23 frontman Tom Shear's new label, 23db. The band members' accomplished musical past with a variety of other bands is thoroughly evident on this ten-track album, which seamlessly melds aspects of EBM, Synthpop, and Trance. Over this musical canvas, singer Darren Miller unwinds literate, deeply personal lyrics with an ease that belies the band's newcomer status. Featuring production and additional programming by Assemblage 23's Tom Shear, "Obsolete" is a throbbing, hook-laden dancefloor monster
